

# THE "ORIGINAL TEXT"

- Of all the thousands of biblical mss, no two are identical, and not one is a ms written by the original author
- What does this fact imply for the idea of the authority of the original mss?

# WHAT IS TEXTUAL CRITICISM?

- Usual definition: the art and science of recovering the original text of a literary work
- Preferable definition with respect to the Bible: the art and science of evaluating variant readings, studying the transmission of the work in antiquity, and reconstructing earlier written forms of the work

# WHY TEXTUAL CRITICISM?

- The text of the Bible was modified as it was passed down
  - +sometimes accidentally
  - +sometimes intentionally
- for a variety of reasons

# DUPLICATION OF LETTERS, WORD, OR PHRASE (DITTOGRAPHY)

- Ezek 16: 6: and I said to you in your blood, "Live!", and I said to you in your blood, "Live!" most witnesses] phrase only once in a few witnesses
- Acts 19:34: Great is Artemis of the Ephesians! most witnesses] phrase repeated in B

# OMISSION OF LETTERS, WORD, OR PHRASE (HAPLOGRAPHY)

- Gen 4:8 MT: And Cain said to Abel his brother ...]
  LXX: And Cain said to Abel his brother, let us go into the field
- ★ Jn 1:3 apart from him not one thing has come into being ○ΥΔ∈ ∈N] apart from him nothing has come into being ○ΥΔ∈N

### OMISSION BY PARABLEPSIS (EYE SKIP)

- \* Jdg 16:13-14: "And he said to her, "If you weave the seven braids of my hair with a web [and fasten it to the wall with a pin, I'll grow weak and become like any man." So she put him to sleep and wove the seven braids of his hair with a web] and fastened it with a pin. MT omits portion in brackets
- In 17:15 B: I do not pray that you take them [from the world but that you keep them] from the evil one

# LETTERS/WORDS THAT LOOK SIMILAR (GRAPHICAL CONFUSION)

- Jer 35:11: Come, let us enter Jerusalem to get away from the armies of the Babylonians and the armies of Aram □¬ℵ MT] ... and the armies of Edom □¬ℵ P
- Matt 1:4: Aminadab most mss] Aminadam some minuscules—both b and m resemble modern u in certain forms of minuscule script

# LETTERS/WORDS THAT SOUND SIMILAR (AUDITORY CONFUSION)

- Ps 100:3: he has made us, and not we ourselves אנחנו MT ketiv] he has made us, and we are his ולו אנחנו MT qere
- Rom 5:1: we have peace with God €XOM€N] let us have peace with God €XWM€N

# CORRECTION OF A PASSAGE WITH PERCEIVED THEOLOGICAL PROBLEMS

- Jdg 18:30: Jonathan, son of Gershom, son of Moses (משה) MT mss] Jonathan, son of Gershom, son of Manasseh (מ<sup>נ</sup>שה) MT
- Jn 7:8: I am not going up to this festival some mss] I am not yet going up to this festival most mss

# CORRECTION/CLARIFICATION OF GEOGRAPHICAL, HISTORICAL, OR FACTUAL ISSUES

- Gen 2:2: and God completed his work on the seventh day MT] and God completed his work on the sixth day SP LXX P
- Mk 1:2: through Isaiah the prophet oldest mss] through the prophets most mss

# 10TH COMMANDMENT: SP

Exod 20:17b SP: And it shall be when the Lord your God brings you into the land of the Canaanites, where you are entering, to possess it, that you shall take for yourselves large stones and plaster them with plaster, and you shall write on the stone all the words of this law, and it shall be when you cross over the Jordan, you shall set up these stones, which I have commanded you today, on Mount Gerizim, and you shall build there an altar to the Lord your God, an altar of stones not worked with iron, with whole stones you shall built the altar of the Lord your God, and you shall offer on it offerings to the Lord your God, and you shall sacrifice peace offerings, and you shall eat there and drink before the Lord your God....

### DAVID & GOLIATH: 1 SAM 17

- X LXX omits 17:12-31 (David sent to front lines with food for his brothers)
- X LXX omits 17:41 (Saul's armor bearer)
- LXX omits 17:50 (no sword in David's hand)
- LXX omits 17:55-58 (Saul asks who David is)
- LXX omits 18:1-5 (David & Jonathan)

### HOW OLD WAS SAUL? 1 SAM 13:1

- MT: Saul was a year old when he began to reign, and he reigned two years over Israel.
- × LXX: omit
- LXX<sup>L</sup>: Saul was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned two years over Israel.
- × T<sup>J</sup>: Saul was like a one year old with no sins when he became king. Then he reigned for two years over Israel.
- P: Saul was thirty-one years old when he became king over the kingdom of Israel.
- XJV: Saul reigned one year, and when he had reigned two years over Israel,
- NRSV: Saul was . . . years old when he began to reign; and he reigned . . . and two years over Israel.

### JN 7:53-8:11—WOMAN CAUGHT IN ADULTERY

- Maritted in earliest and best mss & versions, Alexandrian & Western
- \* Added here in later mss & versions, Byzantine
- Added here with marks indicating uncertainty in few witnesses
- Added after Jn 7:36; 21:25 (end of book); Lk 21:38; 24:53 (end of book) few mss

### MK 16:9-20—ENDING OF MARK

- Omitted in oldest mss & several old versions & fathers
- \* Added in most witnesses
- \* "But they reported briefly to Peter and those with him all that they had been told. And after these things Jesus himself sent out through them, from east to west, the sacred and imperishable proclamation of eternal salvation" in several witnesses, usually before 16:9-20


# BETWEEN MK 16:14-15—FREER LOGION

\* "And they excused themselves, saying, 'This age of lawlessness and unbelief is under Satan, who does not allow the truth and power of God to prevail over the unclean things of the spirits [or, does not allow what lies under the unclean spirits to understand the truth and power of God]. Therefore reveal your righteousness now' - thus they spoke to Christ. And Christ replied to them, 'The term of years of Satan's power has been fulfilled, but other terrible things draw near. And for those who have sinned I was handed over to death, that they may return to the truth and sin no more, in order that they may inherit the spiritual and incorruptible glory of righteousness that is in heaven."

- Bless God and die—MT
- Say some words to the Lord and die—LXX
- Revile your God and die—P
- Curse God and die—original



# **EXOD 34:29—HORNS OF MOSES**

- Moses did not know that the skin of his face was shining (קרן) because he had been talking with God—MT
- \* He did not know that his face was horned (cornuta = קרן) because of contact with the word of God—V

### JN 1:18—ONLY-BEGOTTEN GOD?

- Only-begotten (unique) God—earliest Alexandrian witnesses
- Only-begotten (unique) Son—most witnesses, Western & Byzantine
- Only-begotten Son of God—a few witnesses
- Only-begotten—two witnesses

# REV 13:18-666 OR 616?

- × 666—most witnesses
- × 616—a few witnesses
